HOW TO SCHEDULE A LOBBY VISIT

- Call the Capitol switchboard (202-224-3121) and ask to be connected to your Representative's or Senator's office.
- Once connected, ask to speak with the scheduler, who keeps the calendar for the member of Congress.
- Introduce yourself as a constituent, stating where you live.
- Tell the scheduler the issue you would like to discuss with your lawmaker the Clean Water Protection Act in the House or the Appalachia Restoration Act in the Senate.
- Request a 15-minute meeting with your member of Congress (you may be given a shorter appointment, but any time is better than none). Make an effort to meet with your Representative directly. If they are completely unavailable, then ask to schedule an appointment with the legislative aide responsible for environmental issues.
- The scheduler may ask for the meeting request in writing or via email. You can use the following example:
