



HOW TO SCHEDULE A LOBBY VISIT

- Find the contact information for your Member's local offices here:
<http://www.congress.org/congressorg/directory/congdir.tt>
- When calling, ask to speak with the scheduler, who keeps the calendar for the member of Congress.
- Introduce yourself as a constituent, stating where you live.
- Tell the scheduler the issue you would like to discuss with your lawmaker – the **Clean Water Protection Act** in the House or the **Appalachia Restoration Act** in the Senate.
- Request a 15-minute meeting with your member of Congress (you may be given a shorter appointment, but any time is better than none). Make an effort to meet with your Representative directly. If they are completely unavailable, then ask to schedule an appointment with the legislative aide responsible for environmental issues.
- The scheduler may ask for the meeting request in writing or via email. You can use the following example:

ATTN: Scheduler

Dear Representative or Senator_____,

My name is _____ from _____. I am constituent in your district/ state and I would like to meet with you during (dates you are available). I would like to discuss an issue about which I care very deeply—ending the practice of mountaintop removal coal mining in Appalachia.

As your constituent, I would like the opportunity to share my perspective on this issue. (If other constituents will be joining you insert their names here) will accompany me for this visit. I look forward to meeting with you. Thank you very much for considering my request.
